






EZEKIEL WATCHMAN OF ISRAEL

JUDGEMENT of JUDAH & JERUSALEM Ezekiel 1-24



C7TIIT

- The Lord appeared to Ezekiel as a mighty warrior riding out of the clouds on his war chariot. The Lord was present with His people in Babylon; He had not abandoned them.
- > These angelic creatures serve as the Lord's royal attendants around His throne
- The sovereign Lord of heaven asserted His sovereignty in the land of Babylon, and no human ruler or army would be able to oppose Him.
- Ezekiel's role as a prophet is compared to the work of a "watchman" who stood on the city wall and warned the people
- Ezekiel portrayed the siege of Jerusalem to show the exiles that the Lord would not tolerate the demeaning of His holiness.



C7FVIC

- Ezekiel's dramatic language was/is necessary because the exiles treated the prophet's warnings as empty proverbs or predictions for the distant future,
- Ezekiel told three parables to portray the sinfulness of Judah and the certainty of coming judgment (Ezekiel 15–17).
 - o Parable of the useless vine
 - o Parable of the spiritual adultery
 - o Parable of two eagles and a vine
- Ezekiel 20 gives one of the most negative assessments of Israel's history in the entire Old Testament. The Davidic dynasty would be on pause until its restoration at the time near the end of the age.



C7TVIT

Some Key Verses:

- Now it came to pass in the thirtieth year, in the fourth month, on the fifth day of the month, as I was among the captives by the River Chebar, that the heavens were opened and I saw visions of God. Ezekiel 1:1
- And above the firmament over their heads was the likeness of a throne, in appearance like a sapphire stone; on the likeness of the throne was a likeness with the appearance of a man high above it. Ezekiel 1:26
- > And He said to me: "Son of man, I am sending you to the children of Israel, Ezekiel 2:3a
- "Son of man, I have made you a watchman for the house of Israel; therefore hear a word from My mouth, and give them warning from Me: When I say to the wicked, 'You shall surely die,' and you give him no warning, nor speak to warn the wicked from his wicked way, to save his life, that same wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood I will require at your hand. Ezekiel 3:17-18



- ➤ One-third of you shall die of the pestilence, and be consumed with famine in your midst; and one-third shall fall by the sword all around you; and I will scatter another third to all the winds, and I will draw out a sword after them. Ezekiel 5:12
- "Yet I will leave a **remnant**, so that you may have some who escape the sword among the nations, when you are scattered through the countries. Ezekiel 6:8
- They will throw their silver into the streets, And their gold will be like refuse; Their silver and their gold will not be able to deliver them In the day of the wrath of the Lord; They will not satisfy their souls, Nor fill their stomachs, Because it became their stumbling block of iniquity. Ezekiel 7:19

- Then He said to me, "The iniquity of the house of Israel and Judah is exceedingly great, and the land is full of bloodshed, and the city full of perversity; for they say, 'The Lord has forsaken the land, and the Lord does not see!' Ezekiel 9:9
- Then I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within them, and take the stony heart out of their flesh, and give them a heart of flesh, that they may walk in My statutes and keep My judgments and do them; and they shall be My people, and I will be their God. Ezekiel 11:19-20
- And say to the people of the land, 'Thus says the Lord God to the inhabitants of Jerusalem and to the land of Israel: "They shall eat their bread with anxiety, and drink their water with dread, so that her land may be emptied of all who are in it, because of the violence of all those who dwell in it. Ezekiel 12:19
- ➤ "Son of man, these men have set up their idols in their hearts, and put before them that which causes them to stumble into iniquity. Should I let Myself be inquired of at all by them? Ezekiel 14:3

- "As I live," says the Lord God, "neither your sister Sodom nor her daughters have done as you and your daughters have done. Look, this was the iniquity of your sister Sodom: She and her daughter had <u>pride</u>, fullness of food, and abundance of idleness; neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy. And they were haughty and committed abomination before Me; therefore I took them away as I saw fit. Ezekiel 16:48-50
- "Moreover you took your sons and your daughters, whom you bore to Me, and these you sacrificed to them to be devoured. Were your acts of harlotry a small matter, Ezekiel 16:20 30 "How degenerate is your heart!" says the Lord God, "seeing you do all these things, the deeds of a brazen harlot. Ezekiel 16:30
- In you they take bribes to shed blood; you take usury and increase; you have made profit from your neighbors by extortion, and have forgotten Me," says the Lord God. Ezekiel 22:12
- Again, in the ninth year, in the tenth month, on the tenth day of the month, the word of the Lord came to me, saying, "Son of man, write down the name of the day, this very day—the king of Babylon started his siege against Jerusalem this very day. Ezekiel 24:1-2








 - Egypt


